Mr. Orlando is president, chief executive officer (CEO) and a member of the Board of Directors for Covanta Holding Corporation. He was named president and CEO of Covanta Holding Corporation in October 2004 and was elected to the Board of Directors in September 2005. He serves on one board committee: Public Policy and Technology.

Throughout his more than 25-year tenure with Covanta, Mr. Orlando has held numerous leadership positions in business development, construction, operations and finance. Prior to becoming CEO, he was senior vice president, Business and Financial Management of Covanta Energy. From January 2001 until March 2003, Mr. Orlando served as senior vice president responsible to lead the company's energy-from-waste business.

Mr. Orlando earned a Bachelor of Science degree in Civil Engineering from Villanova University (Villanova, PA) and a Master of Business Administration in Finance from Seton Hall University (South Orange, NJ). He is currently the chair of the Salvation Army New Jersey State Advisory Board and is also a former member of Villanova University's Engineering Advisory Board.

His industry accolades include national recognition as the top Alternative Energy Sector CEO in Institutional Investor's 2013 All-America Executive Team. He was also recognized by the National Safety Council as one of the 2013 CEOs Who "Get It" and featured in the Council's Safety + Health magazine. He has also been named a top 100 CEO Leader in STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics) by STEMconnector®. In addition, Mr. Orlando received the American Society of Mechanical Engineers Achievement Award for outstanding contributions to the art and science of engineering and was honored with the Energy Innovator Award from the United States Department of Energy's Office of Energy Efficiency and Renewable Energy.
